To use a range of materials creatively to design and make products.

Year 1

Crayon

Wax

Paint – Refining basic painting skills and technique (hand and eye co-ordination with a brush)

Clay – Thumb pot with simple patterns etched in.

Chalk pastels

Pencil

Paper – Collage using block colour.

Year 2

Paint – Technique of pointillism and greater colour mixing.

Paper – Collage of whole images

Clay – Shaping from a 'lump', combining clay using 'slip' and precision mark making in clay.

To use drawing, paintings and sculpture to **develop and share their ideas, experiences and imagination.**

Year 1

Children share ideas about images using mind maps of their thoughts.

Children share their artwork with family and friends during Autumn 2 'Let's Celebrate' performance.

Year 2

Children gain their ideas from artist's work and adapt these in their own work.

When sharing their work, children discuss how to improve their art with each other.

To develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space.

Year 1

Children are taught these skills individually at basic level.

Year 2

Children experiment with colour using paint. They mix colours and make them lighter or darker.

With pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space the children decide themselves how to use this best in their piece of work.
