Full opening of school

Dear Parents/Carers,

School will be open to all pupils from Monday 8th March. This is great news and we are now making plans to ensure that the COVID safety measures we had in place last September are back in place to welcome all pupils back into the building.

School entrances/start times

Reception class will enter through the door off Lower Church Lane street – this door will open at 8.45am

The main school gates will open at 8.55am. This entrance can then be used for the children of Nursery, Year 1, Year 2, Year 3 and Year 4.

Nursery children will enter through the Nursery door.

Year 1 and 2 children will go through the playground and enter school through the conservatory entrance.

Year 3 and 4 children will go through the playground and enter school through the back KS2 door.

Year 5 and 6 children will enter school from the entrance off Lower Church Lane (the front of the building on the street)

Halcyon Hub children will enter school through their usual door.

Breaktimes and Lunchtimes

We will be able to run breaktimes and lunchtimes in the same way as the Autumn term. All classes were able to have staggered 'bubble' breaks throughout the day.

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 pupils will be able to have lunch in the hall (seated in three separate areas). Years 3,4,5 and 6 will have their lunch in their classrooms.

School exits/finish times

Reception class will leave through the door off Lower Church Lane street – this door will open at 3.15pm

The main school gates will open at 3.15pm. This entrance can then be used for the collection of children from Nursery, Year 1, Year 2, Year 3 and Year 4.

Nursery children will leave through the Nursery door from 3.15pm

Year 1 and 2 children can be collected from the conservatory entrance from 3.20pm

Year 3 and 4 children can be collected from the back KS2 door at 3.25pm

Year 5 and 6 children can be collected from the entrance off Lower Church Lane (the front of the building on the street) from 3.25pm.

School lunches

School lunches will operate as usual. Children can bring a packed lunch or you can order through the Dolce website.

After school clubs

We will not be able to offer any after school provision under the current restrictions as we have to maintain our class 'bubble' groups.

Assemblies

We will not be able to do any assemblies in school as we have to ensure that the class 'bubbles' do not mix unnecessarily. Each classroom will continue to have their own assemblies and issue weekly certificates.

Please note that there may still be a need for 'bubble' closures if we have any confirmed positive cases.

We look forward to seeing you all again on Monday 8th March.
