- 4. Parents will be informed if they have been successful in gaining a place in a specific club by **Tuesday** 14th October.
- 5. Parents can then officially consent / pay to secure the place by **Thursday 16th October**. After this date, children on the waiting list will be contacted and offered any available places. **You MUST consent, even if the club if free!**
