AFTER-SCHOOL CLUBS – Spring 2 2025/26

As part of our after-school club programme, we are now able to confirm the schedule for the second half of the Spring 2026 term. **This is NOT first come, first served!** We will continue with parents expressing an interest in a club/s in the first instance, ranking your choices, I then personally ensure fairness of club allocation – this can be based on clubs previously accessed and the number of clubs requested.

Please complete the form in your RMP App, these can be found in the forms section. Please note, this can only be completed once for each child.

Please only request clubs that your child is genuinely interested in.

1. Clubs that are available are shared (see the bottom of this letter).
2. Parents express an interest for a club/clubs by using this form by **4pm on Thursday 5th February**
3. I will allocate places fairly based on a number of factors, such as: previous access to clubs this year, the number of clubs applied for etc – we will hold a waiting list, should any successful children no longer want the place.
4. Parents will be informed if they have been successful in gaining a place in a specific club by **Monday 9th February – this will be via a message in the RMP app**
5. Parents can then officially consent / pay to secure the place by **Wednesday 11th February**. After this date, children on the waiting list will be contacted and offered any available places. **You MUST consent, even if the club is free!**

I hope that this approach will ensure fairness for all parents and children in being able to come to a club, my aim is that every child in school is able to attend at least one club over the year. You will notice that some clubs are chargeable, this is to ensure we cover the costs of the staff leading them and any resources we need.

All clubs will start w/b 23rd February to W/B 23rd March (5 weeks – please note, there will be no club on Wednesday 25th March due to the Easter Disco term).

At the bottom of this letter you will find a schedule of clubs which indicates the following:

- The day of the week that the club will be held
- The teacher who will be responsible for the club
- The type of club and what it entails
- The year group(s) the club is applicable to
- The cost and what it will cover
