## **Entrances and Exits**

<u>Nursery</u> - Please access the classroom via the **nursery playground gate**, you will be able to see your child's environment whilst you wait for your appointment time. Please do not arrive any more than **10 minutes before your slot** to avoid overcrowding in the classroom. If you have a child in other year groups, please exit via the nursery gates and walk around to the playground conservatory (see below)

Reception – Year 6 - Please enter school via the playground conservatory. In the hall you will find your child's books, once you have the books, please make your way to the chairs that are positioned outside your child's classroom. This is where you be able to wait until the class teacher calls you in for your meeting. After your meeting, please exit school via the playground conservatory. If you have a child in nursery, please leave via the conservatory and walk round to the nursery classroom door. We would advise that you arrive no earlier than 20 minutes before your appointment time, if you wish, you can continue to look at your child's work in the hall after your appointment has finished.
