Autumn Pupil Reports

Today your child will bring home a report card which shows their assessment grades at end of autumn. These are based on assessments that were completed by your child's teacher just before the Christmas holidays. This grade is given using evidence from standardised tests and the day to day work we see your child produce. The assessments have been moderated with senior leaders to ensure that they are accurate.

The report contains their current level for reading, writing and maths (please see the table for what the codes mean). We have also included their target grade for the end of the year, this is an aspirational target based on previous results and what we know about your child, so please do not worry if your child is not at that level yet.

This year we have added information about progress in reading writing and maths, so that you can see if your child has made more than expected, expected or less expected progress since the end of last year. If your child has made less than expected progress in any area, the teacher will have noted some next steps, which we will be working on this term along with some ideas for how you can help at home.

Parents evening is the perfect time to discuss this report in more detail, so please raise any queries during this time, your child's teacher will be happy to answer any questions or concerns you may have and can explain how you can also support your child at home to ensure they reach their full potential.

For attendance, our school target is 96%. Good attendance supports children in their learning, their friendships and their happiness at school. If your child's attendance is below 90%, they are considered persistently absent

We hope you find this report card useful and we look forward to seeing you at parents' evening soon.
