Arrangements for our Autumn Disco

Dear Parents and Carers,

It is now approaching the time for our Autumn disco, so I wanted to write to you with the finer details. In terms of clubs that run on Thursdays, these will still go ahead if your child wants to attend. **For football club, please pick your child up from the forest conservatory at 4:30pm.** Children in KS2 who want to attend football club and go to the Disco after, should bring their clothes for the disco in a named bag so that they can change into these when football club finishes and go straight to the disco.

Reception, years 1 and 2 – if your child wishes to get changed before the disco, please send their disco clothes in a named bag. The children will get changed into their disco clothes after school and will go straight to the disco. The disco will end promptly at 4:30pm – the playground gate will open at 4:25pm, please collect your child from the conservatory.

Years 3,4,5 and 6 – The children will need to go home after school at 3:25pm as normal, then come back for the disco. Staff will open the playground gates at 4:40pm and then all children will enter via the forest conservatory at 4:45pm. Children will be dismissed at 6pm – years 3/4 from the forest conservatory and years 5/6 from the main conservatory.

Mobile phones

These will not be allowed, please ensure your child leaves them at home and does not bring them to the disco. We will be unable to monitor any photos and videos being taken, which creates a safeguarding risk. We would much prefer the children have fun with their friends, away from their devices. If a phone is seen, it will be confiscated and handed back to parents at the end of the disco.

Collection

All children will need to be collected by an adult– no one will be allowed to walk home alone, even if your child is in year 6 and this is usually allowed. Please be prompt when collecting your child.

Tuck Shop

We will be selling a range of drinks, crisps and sweets, these will range in price from 30p – 60p. If you wish your child to be able to purchase snacks, please send them with some money (small change please).

EYFS/ KS1 - please send any money you want your child to spend in a named envelope, which can be handed to their teacher on Thursday morning for safe keeping. KS2 can bring their own money to look after for the later disco.

If you have not already purchased a ticket, please do so by the end of today, via School Money
